## **Church Fellowship Hall Rental Policy:**

The church's fellowship hall, downstairs' hall, is available for use by parishioners after any church service (liturgy, vespers, etc.) for fellowship. It is also often used by parishioners after a baptism, chrismation, memorial service, and funeral. There is no charge for a parishioner to use the church hall after these types of services and "sacraments."

The church's fellowship hall is also available to parishioners who would like to rent it out for special occasions. Those occasions could be a birthday, graduation, or anniversary party. For parishioners who would like to rent the church hall for such an occasion, the church would kindly ask for a minimum suggested donation of \$350, so that we can pay a cleaning service to clean the church hall prior and following to your event. This will provide the church the ability to make sure the hall is ready for your event and the next event.

For non-parishioners who are using the Church for a sacramental event, there is an option to rent the hall in connection with the event. Please note that the cleaning fee is to sanitize tables and cooking areas and deep clean restrooms. Those hosting an event must dispose of all food, leftovers, etc. in the trash and generally clean up after their guests.

Fees may be reduced on the recommendation of the parish priest and concurrence of the Parish Council chair on a case by case basis for those in need.
